CURRICULUM

Bible | Positive Action for Christ

- Study of the Old Testament and its relevance to fifth-grade life.
- Emphasis on fostering a love for Bible study and prayer.
- Memorization of weekly verses and quizzes based on lesson topics.

READING | A Beka

- Focus on fluent comprehension and understanding.
- Ability to comprehend reading material and answer related questions.
- Weekly reading vocabulary, bi-weekly timed reading drills.
- Monthly book reports
- Oral reading graded

PENMANSHIP | A Beka

- Cursive writing practice across subjects.
- Improvement of penmanship through exercises and weekly tests.
- Emphasis on neatness and correct cursive formation.
- Weekly creative writing exercises.

SPELLING | A Beka

- 34 spelling lists for memorization and weekly tests.
- Word lists related to the grammar and reading curriculum.
- Poetry memorization.

MATH | Saxon

- Mastery of multiplication and division.
- Handling complex division problems, percentages, and fractions (including improper fractions, mixed numbers, and reduction).
- Mental math practice, fractions operations, geometry, shapes, angles, and basic calculator skills.
- Weekly tests to assess learning progress.

GRAMMAR | A Beka

- Quizzes and tests throughout the year.
- Mastery of subjects, predicates, and all eight parts of speech.
- In-depth study of verbs, nouns, pronouns, adjectives, adverbs, prepositions, conjunctions, and interjections.

COMPOSITION | A Beka

- Reviewing punctuation and capitalization rules from previous grades.
- Structured writing: oral book reports, well-structured sentences, letter writing, and essays.
- Development of paragraphs, topic sentences, and utilizing the writing process for research papers.
- Learning to effectively use the library and write reports.

HISTORY | Heritage Studies

- Study of the beginning of the USA to present-day history.
- Memorize 50 states and capitals starting by region.
- Quizzes and tests throughout the year.

SCIENCE/HEALTH | A Beka

- Topics include vertebrates, invertebrates, mammals, insects, energy, weather, outer space, and health curriculum.
- Science experiments, reports, and science fair projects.
- Understanding body systems, organs, healthy eating, and living.

- Students will study the woodwind section in the orchestra with a focus on the clarinet & flute.
